Staff Reports and Requests:

A. Manager's Report – Steve Forrester

Mr. Forrester reported: that Eric Klann wanted to thank the councilors that took the tour of city facilities; work continues on the first two year budget and is going well; we are finalizing the police facility process; we have been working on water resource projects and then provided a water flow update at the dams.

Mike Kasberger, Assistant City Engineer provided more details on the water levels at various locations around Crook County and Prineville.

B. Committee Reports

Councilor Merritt stated that she had been to a housing meeting, roundabout meeting, Bowman Dam hydro meeting, and a 1st graders Story Line field trip.

Eric Klann, City Engineer explained that there are two story lines going on now where 1st graders are becoming planners, and 2nd graders are going to dig up dinosaur eggs as paleontologists.

Councilor Papke attended a School Facilities Committee meeting and they are wrapping up the work and presented the report to the School Board. The report included an evaluation of the school district buildings, significant repairs that need to be made and enrollment numbers.

Mayor Uffelman went to a Central Oregon Cities Organization (COCO) meeting and League of Oregon Cities meeting and talked about HB 2408 which limits benefits of the Enterprise Zone.

Councilor Papke provided an update on the FAA funding bill that is still alive and continues to move forward.

C. Safety Committee Update - Lisa Morgan / Pat Goehring

Lisa Morgan, City Recorder / Risk Manager and Pat Goehring, Public Works Superintendent went through a power point presentation that highlighted accomplishments of the Safety Committee, and hours of safety training completed city wide.
