Re:

Downtown Strategic Plan (DSP) Committee Grant Program.

This memorandum is an update on the Downtown Strategic Plan (DSP) Committee Grant Program. At the last DSP Committee, the Committee ranked the 9 projects that were submitted for the DSP Committee Grant Program. The projects were ranked 1 to 9 by 11 committee members.

The City Council budgeted dollars for this program that were able to possibly fund 4 and a half projects of the 9 proposed projects. The Chamber of Commerce has stepped forward to fill the funding gap for the 5th project, so the 5th project is now funded if the Council chooses to fund the projects. The DSP Committee respectfully requests the City Council approve funding for the top 5 ranked applications.

The top five projects are Projects 1, 2, 3a, 3b and 4 in the table below. (Projects ranked 3a and 3b had a tied score from the Committee.) The applications are attached to this memorandum for your review.

The Elks has been for several years, serving the Veterans, the Prineville Chapter of Band of Brothers and the Veterans' homes in White City and The Dalles.


We help the needy through Christmas Food Baskets and special projects as they occur. The American Red Cross holds their local blood drive at our lodge.



This is but a brief encapsulation of what the Elks do and why we are so important to Prineville and the Central Oregon Community.




We just found out about the Downtown Improvement Grant. Given, we are not in the immediate focus area, however, we would like to try our very best to be considered. Our property is located at 235 SE Combs Flat Rd. We are directly across the street from the Ochoco Lumber Office, and just a stones throw away from the new, beautiful St. Charles Hospital. There is literally new construction going on all around us. There is the new Ochoco Creek Bridge on one side of our property, and the new access road to the previous Cecil Sly School on the other side of our property. Not to mention, all the exciting developments going on with the mill property in front of us. We feel our property is very high profile and visible to all the surrounding businesses, and all the traffic, and patrons, that go with that. However, that being said, quite frankly the outside appearance of our business/home is embarrassing and does not reflect well on our business or the surrounding ones. Our main concerns are the front exterior. It is in need of new windows, garage doors, and paint. My husband is the sole proprietor of his own building design business: TE Building Design. He has worked on, or been solely responsible for many homes and business design plans in, and around Prineville over the last 15 plus years. He has his home office at our address, and we desperately would like an exterior that properly reflects his talents as a building designer, and a location he can proudly meet with his clients at. We bought the property from my husbands parents in October 2008, it was the house my husband grew up in. We had hopes for a full remodel. However, it was shortly after we purchased, that the economy took a turn for the worst. My husband's construction dependent business came nearly to a halt, and we were pregnant with our first child. Much to his credit he wanted if at all possible to keep me from working outside the home to take care of any children we had. Over 6 years ago he took a job with Prineville Disposal and still works there today, and has also kept his design company going. He works very hard and long hours, but the budget is still tight, and business/home improvements have had to be put on the back burner. We do what we can out of pocket, but so far this had not allowed for us to do the face-lift our business/home is in desperate need of. We are willing to make the sacrifices to invest in this project, and confidant we can finish in the allotted time. So we are hopeful, and we would like to request this grant, and have assistance to make the needed improvements. We feel this would be mutually beneficial for both the City of Prineville, and us, to have a business and home we can be proud of.
