IN THE MATTER of opposing Measure 97 being before the Court on this, the 7<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2016, and the Court being in regular session for the transaction of County business; and

WHEREAS, the Court does not support the citizens of Sherman County paying higher consumer prices to cover the cost of tax increases due to Measure 97;

WHEREAS, the Court does not support a tax on gross sales which some Sherman County businesses would be required to pay regardless of whether or not they make a profit;

WHEREAS, the revenue from taxes generated by Measure 97 would be paid to the state General Fund and are not guaranteed to fund schools, healthcare, or other needed services;

WHEREAS, supporting Measure 97 would impose a tax that will reduce income, employment, and population growth in Sherman County;

WHEREAS, a new tax on gross sales will encourage entities considering investing in Oregon and in Sherman county to invest elsewhere and will slow the creation of private sector job growth;

WHEREAS, Measure 97 is a regressive tax that will heavily burden lower and middle-income families, and Sherman County is comprised of lower and middle-income families;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Sherman County Court opposes a tax on gross sales and opposes Measure 97.
