
Staff Report: Barnes Butte Complex Focus Committee Update and Survey Results

Overview:

During the Barnes Butte Complex Workshop on 7/25/2017, Council requested that staff develop a citizen focus committee to understand the community's desire for the development of the property. Currently, over 30 members of the public are actively participating in the development of the site with the focus committee having officially met three times.

The focus committee developed the below survey that was active for the month of November. The City, County Health Department, Police Department and members of the focus committee shared the survey via social media sites. Over 330 people responded to the survey with the following results.

Land around Barnes Butte has recently been purchased by the City of Prineville. City Council wants to know what you want the land to be used for. The options below are examples of what people might want to see. We are not guaranteeing any activities will end up being on the property. We want to hear from the community about what is important to them.



Below is a list of comments received as part of the survey.

- Tennis courts indoor and outdoor.
- Drive in movie theater
- Disc golf
- New race track and rodeo event grounds
- Pine Nursery Park in Bend would be a good example of some things to do with thia park. A lighted outdoor sports complex could attract tournaments and other events to our community. Moab Utah has a great, NOT massive indoor/outdoor sports conplex that would be a great example. Paved or just maintained bike/hike/running trails would be great as well and another fishing pond would be awesome, if someone took the time to do some maintenance around it for access or built a fishing pier
