Staff Report: Roundabout Feature Direction

Overview:


City Council initiated a Roundabout Feature Committee to make recommendations on a feature for the Tom McCall Roundabout. The Committee's first workshop was held February 13, 2018. The Committee directed staff to create and distribute a survey asking for input from community members, survey results below.

The Committee held a second workshop 6/12/18 to review survey results and discuss next steps. Committee members reviewed a drawing based on the top three themes from survey responses (logging, ranching, and mining).

SURVEY:

A 5 question on-line survey was launched 5/3/18, and 1,017 people responded over the course of several weeks.

- 5/3/18: Launched on Survey Monkey, Facebook, and Twitter: 9846 reached, 180 comments, 58 shares
- 5/17/18: Survey reminder post: 1,550 reached, 14 comments, 2 shares
- Roundabout Committee Workshop post: 1,575 reached, 21 comments, 20 shares

CONSIDERATIONS:

- The City needs to provide a general idea of the roundabout feature layout by August for ODOT to perform the removal of the dirt mound or costs will increase.
- 1,017 people responded to the survey (10.24% of Prineville's population)
- Common themes from the survey included:
 - o Celebrate the history and character of the community
 - o Be timeless
 - o Forest Products, Ranching, Natural resources
 - o Do not waste money and do not look like Bend

OPTIONS FOR MOVING FORWARD:

- 1. Council chooses a theme/design at this time and directs staff to implement.
 - o There may be push back from Committee members who do not like Council's direction.
- 2. Hire a facilitator to help the Committee make a decision.
 - o This may appease the public but not get us much further along.
- 3. Continue the focus group in its current make up.
 - What additional information does the council need to make a decision?
