

ORDINANCE NO. 594

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE NO. 396,
ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE DECLARING FIRE LIMITS FOR THE UNLOADING
OF GASOLINE OR PETROLEUM FUELS AND REGULATING SUCH UNLOADING AND
PROHIBITING THE DISPENSING OF SUCH FUELS EXCEPT BY AN ATTENDANT;
PROVIDING FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY", AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE, OREGON DO ORDAIN
AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 396, passed
by the City Council of the City of Prineville, Oregon and approved
by the Mayor on April 5, 1949, is amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. The term "vehicle" shall mean and include a
truck and trailer or any other vehicle of whatsoever con-
struction or any truck-trailer unit of trucks and trailers
or any other combination of vehicles having a combined
carrying capacity of 2,000 gallons or more".

Inasmuch as various problems have arisen in enforcing the
previous limitation on the carrying capacity of gasoline unloading
vehicles, and inasmuch as it appears to be in the best interests
of the people of the City of Prineville that this ordinance take
effect immediately, an emergency is hereby declared, and this ord-
inance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage
by the City Council and approval by the Mayor.
