

ORDINANCE NO. 604

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF SIDEWALKS  
ADJOINING CERTAIN PROPERTY IN THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE, OREGON AND DE-  
CLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, heretofore the City Council of the City of Prineville has requested that sidewalks be constructed in certain locations in the downtown district of the City,

AND WHEREAS, a majority of the property-owners who had been contacted had complied with the request;

AND WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Prineville deems it to be for the best interest of the public that sidewalks be constructed in certain areas in the City;

NOW THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE, OREGON DO  
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That sidewalks shall be constructed in the following described areas:

1. Between the east property line of Lots 7, 8 and 9, Block 4, First Addition and the west curb line of N. Belknap Street
2. Between the north property line of Lot 12, Block 4, First Addition and the south curb line of E. Second Street
3. Between the west property line of Lot 7, Block 10, First Addition and the east curb line of N. Court Street
4. Between the south property line of the following described property: Beginning at the SW corner of Lot 4, Block 14, MHP; thence N 114°; thence W. 64°; thence S. 114°; thence E. 64° to point of beginning, and the north curb line of W. Third Street.

That the costs of construction of said sidewalks shall be charged and assessed upon and against each lot, or part thereof, or parcel of land adjoining such construction for its proportionate share of such costs.

That said construction of sidewalks shall be done in conformance with plans and specifications on file at the office of the City Recorder of the City of Prineville; and that said construction shall be made to conform to established grades for directly adjoining streets.

Inasmuch as the owners of all the property listed above have been notified in writing on August 11, 1966 and at intervals since, that the City Council considers it in the public interest that said sidewalks shall be constructed; and inasmuch as approaching cold weather makes it necessary that sidewalk construction be done in the near future, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption by the City Council and approval by the Mayor.
