

ORDINANCE NO. 613

AN ORDINANCE TO SET UP CHARGES FOR THE USE OF CITY OF PRINEVILLE AMBULANCES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE, OREGON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the following charges shall be made for the use of City of Prineville ambulances:

Inside City Limits	\$12.50 per call, base
Outside City, within 5 mile radius of City	\$15.00, base
Outside City, base plus 50¢ per mile, one way	
Charge to: Portland	\$90.00
Bend	30.00
Redmond	22.50
Madras	27.50
Charge to take patient to Prineville Airport	5.00
Charge for standby at rodeos or football games or other events	12.50

Section 2. That inasmuch as it appears to be in the best interests of the people of the City of Prineville that this schedule of charges be put into effect so that the income from ambulance calls can be used to help defray the operating and replacement cost of ambulances, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its adoption by the City Council and approval by the Mayor.
