

ORDINANCE NO. 631

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL ORDINANCE NO. 616 PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL AND APPROVED BY THE MAYOR, THE 20th DAY OF NOVEMBER, 1968, PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF COMMERCIAL PARKING PERMITS.

NOW THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 616, an ordinance providing for the issuance of commercial parking permits enacted the 20th day of November, 1968 be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 2. Inasmuch as it is necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the City of Prineville that this ordinance go into effect immediately after its passage, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the City Council and approval by the Mayor.
