

ORDINANCE NO. 649

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY, ABUTTING THE SOUTH SIDE OF SOUTHEAST FIFTH STREET AND DISPENSING WITH A CITY ELECTION ON THE QUESTION.

Whereas, there has been submitted to the City of Prineville a written proposal for annexation to the City by more than two-thirds of the landowners who also own more than two-thirds of the land in the contiguous territory described below which real property therein represents more than two-thirds of the assessed value of all real property in the contiguous territory to be annexed; and,

Whereas, Ordinance No. 646 was passed, initiating the annexation of said territory, calling a hearing and directing that notice be given thereon, and since the hearing was held at which time all objections or remonstrances with reference to said proposed annexation were considered by the City Council and since that body feels that annexation is to the best interest of the City and of the contiguous territory; now therefore,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Annexation Area. The following described contiguous territory is hereby proclaimed to be annexed to the City of Prineville:

Beginning at a point 80 feet south and 730.6 feet west of the southeast corner of Block 14 of Northwest Townsite Company's First Addition to Prineville, Oregon, according to the official plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the County Clerk for Crook County, Oregon, thence west 369.39 feet, thence south 250 feet, thence east 100.39 feet, thence north 7.4 feet, thence east 107 feet, thence south 150 feet, thence east 162 feet, thence north 392.6 feet to the point of beginning.

Section 2. Record. The City Recorder shall submit to the Secretary of State of Oregon (1) a copy of this ordinance, (2) a copy of the statement of consent of the landowners in the territory annexed, and (3) a copy of Ordinance No. 646 dispensing with an election in the City on the question of annexation. The City Recorder shall also send a description by metes and bounds, or legal subdivisions of the new boundaries of the City within ten (10) days of the effective date of annexation to the Crook County Assessor and Crook County Clerk.
