

ORDINANCE NO. 650

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A PUBLIC HEARING AND NOTICE THEREOF TO CONSIDER WITHDRAWING CERTAIN ANNEXED TERRITORY FROM THE CROOK COUNTY VECTOR CONTROL DISTRICT AND OCHOCO DISTRICT ZONE II - RURAL FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT.

Whereas, it is deemed to be in the best interests of the City of Prineville and the territories annexed by Ordinance Nos. 445, 467, 485, 500, 514, 519, 520, 521, 522, 525, 527, 531, 538, 543, 545, 547, 550, 558, 569, 582, 584, 591, 599, 601, 603, 612, 615, 619, 620, 624, 627, 628, 629, 641 and 649 that such territory be withdrawn from the Crook County Vector Control District and Ochoco District Zone II-Rural Fire Protection District; and

Whereas, the City Council desires to obtain further citizen opinion on the subject of withdrawal and is directed by state law to obtain such opinion;


NOW THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Public Hearing. A public hearing on the question of withdrawing annexed territory from the Crook County Vector Control District and Ochoco District Zone II-Rural Fire Protection District shall be held on May 26, 1970, at 8 o'clock P.M. PDT at the City Hall of the City of Prineville.

Section 2. Notice. The City Recorder shall cause notice of the hearing to be published once each week for two successive weeks prior to the day of the hearing in the Central Oregonian, a newspaper of general circulation within the City. The City Recorder shall also cause notice of this hearing to be posted in four public places within the City for a like period of time.
