

ORDINANCE NO. 688

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY LYING EAST OF NORTH MAIN STREET AND ABUTTING TERRITORY HERETOFORE ANNEXED BY ORDINANCE NO. 658 AND DISPENSING WITH A CITY ELECTION ON THE QUESTION OF ANNEXATION.

WHEREAS, there has been submitted to the City of Prineville a written proposal for annexation to the city by more than two-thirds of the landowners who also own more than two-thirds of the land in the contiguous territory described below which real property therein represents more than two-thirds of the assessed value of all real property in the contiguous territory to be annexed; and,

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 684 was passed, initiating the annexation of said territory, calling a hearing and directing that notice be given thereon, and since the hearing was held at which time all objections or remonstrances with reference to said proposed annexation were considered by the City Council and since that body feels that annexation is to the best interest of the city and of the contiguous territory;

NOW THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Annexation Area. The following described contiguous territory is hereby proclaimed to be annexed to the City of Prineville:

Beginning at a point located N 0° 24' E - 1258.83 ft, N 89° 59' E - 590.00 ft. from the W $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of Sec. 32, T14S, R16E, W.M; thence N 89° 59' E - 150.05 ft; thence S 30° 24' W - 100.12 ft to the boundary of a 50' radius turn around; thence southerly along the 50 ft. radius curve 104.72 ft; thence S 0° 24' W - 462.34 ft to the south boundary of the Sartain property; thence S 89° 39' 12" W - 100.00 ft. to a corner of Prineville City limits; thence N 0° 24' E - 150.00 ft; thence N 89° 39' 12" E - 40.00 ft; thence N 0° 24' E - 335.63 ft; thence S 89° 59' W - 40.00 ft; thence N 0° 24' E - 150.00 ft to the point of beginning, containing 1.2 acres.

Section 2. Record. The City Recorder shall submit to the Secretary of State of Oregon (1) a copy of this ordinance, (2) a copy of the statement of consent of the landowners in the territory annexed, and (3) a copy of Ordinance No. 684 dispensing with an election in the city on the question of annexation. The City Recorder shall also send a description by metes and bounds, or legal subdivisions, of the new boundaries of the city within ten (10) days of the effective date of annexation to the Crook County Assessor and Crook County Clerk.
