

ORDINANCE NO. 698

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 564, "AN ORDINANCE DEFINING OFFENSES; PRESCRIBING PENALTIES, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NOS. 71, 93, 149, 163, 170, 257, and 319"; ADOPTING VARIOUS SECTIONS OF OREGON REVISED STATUTES PERTAINING TO THE TREATMENT OF ALCOHOLICS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE, Oregon ordain as follows:


Section 1. That Section 3 of Ordinance No. 564 is hereby amended to read as follows; to wit:


Section 3. The following enumerated provisions of Oregon Revised Statutes, together with all amendments applicable to cities which may be hereinafter enacted are hereby adopted by reference and made a part of this ordinance: ORS 166.035, ORS 430.305, to and including ORS 430.335, ORS 426.450 to and including ORS 426.470. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 2. Emergency Clause - Now therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its adoption by the City Council and approval by the Mayor.
