

ORDINANCE NO. 708

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 305 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE PUBLIC DANCING WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE AND TO PROVIDE FOR LICENSING THEREOF AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION" AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 305 passed by the City Council and approved by the Mayor September 1934, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. The term "public dance" is hereby defined for the purposes of this ordinance, to be any dance which shall be held or conducted for compensation, or for personal gain, paid directly or indirectly to the owner, proprietor, manager or operator thereof, excepting from the effect of this ordinance, all dances given under the auspices of any recognized lodge, society, organization, public installation or an establishment licensed by the OLCC to dispense beer, wine or liquor.


Now Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage by the City Council, and approval by the Mayor.
