

ORDINANCE NO. 709

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING Section 2. of Ordinance No. 396 (as amended by Ordinance No. 594) entitled "AN ORDINANCE DECLARING FIRE LIMITS FOR THE UNLOADING OF GASOLINE OR PETROLEUM FUELS AND REGULATING SUCH UNLOADING AND PROHIBITING THE DISPENSING OF SUCH FUELS EXCEPT BY AN ATTENDANT; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY."

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 2. of Ordinance No. 396 passed by the City Council and approved by the Mayor April 5, 1949 and amended by Ordinance No. 594 passed by the City Council and approved by the Mayor October 12, 1966, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. The term "Vehicle" shall mean and include a truck and trailer or any other vehicle of whatsoever construction or any truck-trailer unit of trucks and trailers or any other combination of vehicle having a combined carrying capacity of 10,000 gallons or more. (Section 2. as amended by Ordinance No. 594, passed October 12, 1966).

Now Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage by the City Council, and approval by the Mayor.
