

ORDINANCE NO. 738

AN ORDINANCE TO SET UP CHARGES FOR THE USE OF CITY OF PRINEVILLE AMBULANCES, REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 613, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE, OREGON ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the following charges shall be made for the use of City of Prineville ambulances:

City Resident - Inside City:	\$20.00 base
City Resident - Outside City:	\$20.00 base, plus \$1.00 per mile one way
Non-City Resident - Inside City:	\$40.00 base
Non-City Resident - Outside City:	\$40.00 base, plus \$1.00 per mile one way


Charge for standby at rodeos, football games, or other events: \$30.00

Section 2. Ordinance No. 613 is hereby repealed.


Section 3. That inasmuch as it appears to be in the best interests of the people of the City of Prineville that this schedule of charges be put into effect so that the income from ambulance calls can be used to help defray the operating and replacement cost of ambulances, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its adoption by the City Council and approval by the Mayor.
