AN ORDINANCE AND BY-LAWING LOCATING TERRITORY FOR THE ELECTION.
THE TERRITORY AND PROPERTY IS LOCATED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 4. Election Officers. The following persons are hereby appointed judges and clerks of election at the polls listed opposite their names:

Ochoco Grade School

Judge: Beulah Flegel
1st Clerk: Joan Gerke
2nd Clerk: Osa Houston

The foregoing judges and clerks shall each take and subscribe before an officer authorized to administer oaths, or the chairman, that he will honestly and faithfully discharge his duties as election judge or clerk. In case of absence or inability of any judge or clerk so appointed to act at the election, the judges and other clerks present at the prescribed time shall, *viva voce*, choose a qualified registered voter for the election to act in his place. Such substitute must also take and subscribe to an oath.

Section 5. Ballots for Election. The City attorney shall prepare a ballot form and ballot title appropriate for the election, and the city recorder shall supply the officers at the election the ballots necessary therefore.
