

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN TERRITORY SUBJECT TO AN ELECTION IN THE TERRITORY AND MAKING PROVISION FOR THE ELECTION.

Whereas, it is found by the City Council of the city of Prineville that it would be in the public interest that certain territory described below be annexed; and

Whereas, said real property is territory contiguous to the city; and Whereas, Ordinance No. 522 was passed, initiating the annexation of the territory described below, calling a hearing and directing that notice be given thereon; and

Whereas, the hearing was held at which time all objections or remonstrances with reference to said proposed annexation were considered by the City Council; now therefore,

The People of the City of Prineville Ordains as follows:

Section 1. Annexation Area. The following described territory contiguous to the city of Prineville is hereby annexed to the city upon the condition that a majority of votes cast in an election in the territory are in favor of annexation:

Beginning at the Northwest corner of the Steve W. Vancey Second Subdivision, as platted in Crook County, Oregon, said point being on the West line of Section 31 in Township 14 South, Range 16 East of the Williamette Meridian, thence South along the West line of said Section 31 a distance of 705 feet, more or less, to a point on the Northernly bank of Celoco Creek, thence Southeasterly following the meanderings of said Northernly bank of Celoco Creek to a point 435 feet North of the South line of said Section 31, thence East following along a line 435 feet North of the South line of said Section 31 a distance of 575 feet, more or less, to a point on the North and South center of said Section 31, thence North along said North and South center line to the center of said Section 31, thence East along the East and West center line of said Section 31 to a point on the Westerly right of way line of Lamonta Road, as located and constructed, thence Northwesterly along said right of way line to a point due East of the Northwest corner of Tract 23 of said Steve W. Vancey Second Subdivision, thence West to the Northeast corner of said Tract 23, thence West along the North line of said Steve W. Vancey Second Subdivision to the point of beginning.

Section 2. Submission to Election. The question whether the territory shall be annexed to the city shall be submitted to the registered voters of the territory at an election to be held from 8 o'clock a.m. until 8 o'clock p.m. November 4, 1925.

Section 3. Notice of Election. The city recorder shall give notice in the manner required by ORS 222.120. The published notice of the election shall appear in the Central Oregonian, a newspaper of general circulation within said territory, and also. The notice shall state the question to be submitted, shall contain a legal description and map of the boundaries of the territory, and invite the registered voters of the territory to vote on the question. The notice shall state the polling places shall be the same as those used for the regular biennial election.

Section 4. Election Officers. The following persons are hereby appointed judges and clerks of election at the polls listed opposite their names:

Ochoco Grade School

Judge: Beulah Flegel
1st Clerk: Joan Gerke
2nd Clerk: Osa Houston

The foregoing judges and clerks shall each take and subscribe before an officer authorized to administer oaths, or the chairman, that he will honestly and faithfully discharge his duties as election judge or clerk. In case of absence or inability of any judge or clerk so appointed to act at the election, the judges and other clerks present at the prescribed time shall, viva voce, choose a qualified registered voter for the election to act in his place. Such substitute must also take and subscribe to an oath.

Section 5. Ballots for Election. The City attorney shall prepare a ballot form and ballot title appropriate for the election, and the city recorder shall supply the officers at the election the ballots necessary therefore.
