

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2.050 OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE ZONING ORDINANCE OF 1968 AND THEREBY EFFECTING AN AMENDMENT TO THE PRINEVILLE ZONING MAP.

NOW THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 2.290 Zone Change. Section 2.050 of the City of Prineville Zoning Ordinance of 1968 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following subsection.

(24) That territory described as

Beginning at the northeasterly corner of tract fifteen (15) of Steve W. Yancey Addition, according to the official plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the County Clerk for Crook County, Oregon;

Thence North  $44^{\circ}22'$  West 157.00 feet;

Thence South  $75^{\circ}50'$  West 250.00 feet;

Thence South 303.65' along the West line of said tract 15;

Thence East 353.00' to a point on the West right-of-way line of North Harwood Street as such is located and constructed;

Thence North 253.40' along the West R.O.W. of said Harwood Street to the point of beginning.

.....is hereby reclassified from Limited Residential (R-1) to Outlying Commercial (C-2).
