

ORDINANCE NO. 796

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO LIQUOR LICENSE RECOMMENDATION FEES AND AMENDING
ORDINANCE NO. 477

WHEREAS, the Oregon Liquor Control Commission requires every applicant for a license for the sale, manufacture, and distribution of alcoholic liquors to obtain a recommendation on said application from the City Council if the place of business of the applicant is within an incorporated City.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Every applicant for a license for the sale, manufacture or distribution of alcoholic liquors whose place of business is located within the City limits of the City of Prineville who shall apply to the City Council for the recommendation required by the Oregon Liquor Control Commission shall pay to the City or Prineville the sum of \$5.00 for a package liquor license application and/or renewal and \$10.00 for all other liquor license applications and/or renewals.
