

CITY OF PRINEVILLE  
ORDINANCE NO. 799

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE A PORTION OF THAT ALLEY RUNNING NORTH-SOUTH AND CONNECTING WEST 2nd AND WEST 3rd STREETS, LOCATED AT THE WEST END OF PACE'S FIRST ADDITION TO THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of chapter 271, Oregon Revised Statutes, a proper, complete and sufficient petition has been presented to the Council of the City of Prineville, Oregon for the vacation of a designated portion of the alley between West 2nd and West 3rd Streets and at the west end of Pace's First Addition to the City of Prineville; and


WHEREAS, said petition has been read and examined by the Council and the Mayor of the City of Prineville, Oregon, and said Council deems it in the best interests of said City that said petition be granted, and a designated portion of subject alley be vacated;

NOW THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE, OREGON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


The following designated portion of subject alley is hereby vacated: Beginning at the northwest corner of Pace's First Subdivision as on file in the Crook County Clerk's Office in the City of Prineville, Crook County, Oregon; said point of beginning being a point which is 868.1 feet south and 1,751 feet east of the northwest corner of Section 6, Township 15 South, Range 16 East Willamette Meridian, Crook County, Oregon; thence S. 6° E. 233 ft. to the north right of way of West 2nd Street, thence N. 233.2 ft. to a point on the south right of way of U.S. Highway 26, thence S. 86° 21' W. 24.4 ft. to the point of beginning.
