

ORDINANCE NO. 814

AN ORDINANCE SETTING A TIME AND PLACE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION INTO THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE OF CERTAIN PORTIONS OF LAUGHLIN ROAD, REQUESTING THAT CROOK COUNTY SURRENDER JURISDICTION THEREOF AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interest of the City of Prineville that it accept from the County of Crook jurisdiction over a portion of Laughlin Road now located in Crook County, Oregon, between U. S. Highway 26 and North Idlewood Street, and

WHEREAS, the City Council elects to dispense with submitting the annexation of said Laughlin Road to the registered voters of the City,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE, OREGON ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Prineville hereby designates the 12TH day of June, 1979, as the date for a public hearing before the Council on the annexation of the above portion of Laughlin Road into the City of Prineville.


Section 2. This ordinance shall serve as a written request to the County of Crook in the State of Oregon to surrender jurisdiction over said Laughlin Road to the City of Prineville.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effective immediately after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
