

RESOLUTION NO. 1074

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE EXTENSION OF THE SPECIAL ASSESSMENT OF HISTORIC PROPERTIES IN THE CITY

WHEREAS, in 1975 the State of Oregon instituted the Special Assessment Program giving property owners incentive to preserve the rehabilitation of properties listed in the National Register of Historic Places, and

WHEREAS, SB 416 was passed and signed into law by the Governor of the State of Oregon extending the Special Assessment Program through 2010, and


WHEREAS, there are three separate properties in the City of Prineville that qualify for this special assessment, and

WHEREAS, the City of Prineville is committed to preserving our heritage through the preservation of historical buildings,

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE PRINEVILLE CITY COUNCIL:

That the City shall give approval for qualifying property owners to be able to apply for a second term of the special assessment.
