

RESOLUTION NO. 1004

A RESOLUTION TRANSFERRING FUNDS FROM THE PUBLIC WORKS FUND  
CONTINGENCY TO OPERATE THE PRINEVILLE RELOAD FACILITY.

WHEREAS, at the February 8, 2005 Prineville City Council meeting the Council authorized the acquisition of property formerly a portion of the Pine Products Mill to develop a reload facility, and

WHEREAS, the operation of a reload facility will cost money, and

WHEREAS, local budget law requires that the City provide for the means to expend unanticipated City funds, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by staff that the most effective method to provide for that funding is to use an existing fund to operate the reload until the next budget cycle,

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE PRINEVILLE CITY COUNCIL.


The City will create the following budget line items in the Public Works Fund:

Personnel Services	\$ 14,495
Materials and Services	\$ 14,170
Total	\$ 29,065, and

The City will transfer \$29,065 from line 60-49999-9999 "Contingency" for this purpose.
