

RESOLUTION NO. 743

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE, CROOK COUNTY,
OREGON, AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF REIMBURSEMENT DEBT
IN A PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF NOT TO EXCEED \$2,300,000.

The City Council of the City of Prineville, Oregon (the "City") finds:

A. The City reasonably expects to reimburse the expenditures described herein with the proceeds of reimbursement debt to be incurred by the City (known for federal tax purposes as the "Reimbursement Bonds").

B. This declaration of official intention is made pursuant to Section 1.103-18 of the Income Tax Regulations promulgated by the United States Department of the Treasury

C. The maximum principal amount of Reimbursement Bonds expected to be issued is \$2,300,000.

The City Council of the City of Prineville, Oregon resolves:


Section 1. The expenditures with respect to which the City reasonably expects to be reimbursed from the proceeds of Reimbursement Bonds are for the City's Wastewater/Golf Course Project as generally described in the City's Wastewater Facilities Plan, dated March 25, 1991.
