

RESOLUTION NO. 676

A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING CONTINUATION OF THE PRESENT TELEPHONE EXCISE TAX FOR 9-1-1 EMERGENCY TELEPHONE OPERATIONS BEYOND THE 1991 SUNSET DATE

WHEREAS, ORS 401.710 to 401.790 provides for the establishment of 9-1-1 service and system requirements, and

WHEREAS, ORS provides for a tax equal to three percent, which is imposed upon telephone subscribers, and

WHEREAS, the tax is presently scheduled to sunset December 31, 1991, and


WHEREAS, 9-1-1 excise revenues are integral to the operation and financial stability of the 9-1-1 system in Prineville and Crook County,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Prineville supports the continuation of the 9-1-1 service and supports any legislative action required for the continuation of the three per cent telephone excise tax.
