

RESOLUTION NO. 636

A Resolution restricting heavy vehicle traffic on Sixth Street between Harwood Street and Highway 26.

WHEREAS, Prineville Ordinance No. 562, allows the Prineville City Council, if in the public's interest, to designate streets where trucks, machinery or any other large or heavy vehicles are prohibited, and


WHEREAS, Sixth Street between Harwood Street and Highway 26 is narrow and a public school is located next to the street with school bus pickup on Sixth Street. Sixth Street in that location, also has a bad surface which will be adversely affected by vehicles weighing over 8,000 pounds gross volume weight.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED THAT:

1. No trucks, machinery or any other vehicles which weigh more than 8,000 pounds gross volume weight shall be allowed to travel on Sixth Street in Prineville, Oregon between Harwood Street and Highway 26.
2. No vehicle which exceeds 8' feet in width or having a load which exceeds 8' feet in width shall be allowed on Sixth Street in Prineville, Oregon between Harwood Street and Highway 26.
3. This Resolution shall not apply to school buses, emergency vehicles and service vehicles.
