

RESOLUTION NO. 581

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE PART OF RESOLUTION NO. 554 INCIDENTAL TO THE INDUSTRIAL PARK REAL PROPERTY, AND GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE TO EXPLORE ALL GRANTS INCIDENTAL TO THE CITY'S INDUSTRIAL PARK REAL PROPERTY AND ESTABLISHING THE FRAMEWORK FOR A COMMITTEE TO AID IN THE EXPLORATION, APPLICATION AND ARRANGING FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF SUCH GRANTS SHOULD THE GRANTS BE A JOINT CITY/COUNTY EFFORT.

WHEREAS, there may be certain grant monies available to be used for purposes of improvement and/or development of the City's Industrial park real property, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Prineville City Council that such grants be explored, applied for and, if acquired, administered in the best interests of the City, and

WHEREAS, it may be in the best interests of the City for such a grant to be applied for and administered as a joint City of Prineville/Crook County grant,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Prineville:

1. The City Administrator of the City of Prineville be granted the authority on behalf of the City to explore and apply for such grants.
2. Should the exploration and application for such grants be a joint City/County undertaking, the City Administrator shall seek to establish a Committee to aid in attaining and utilizing such grants. This Committee would ideally consist of the City Administrator, a member of the Prineville City Council, the Crook County Judge, a member of the Crook County Court, the Manager of the City of Prineville Railway and a citizen member of the Prineville Business Development Team.
3. It is understood that at all times when acting under the authority hereby granted, the Prineville City Council will be routinely apprised of the current status of said grants.
4. That portion of Resolution No. 554 incidental to the City's Industrial Park real property is hereby amended.
