

RESOLUTION NO. 566

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING JURISDICTION OVER CERTAIN ROADS  
WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE  
FROM CROOK COUNTY, OREGON.

WHEREAS, by order the Board of County Commissioners for  
Crook County, Oregon, on March 12, 1980, found that it was necessary,  
expedient and for the best interest of the County of Crook to surrender  
to the City of Prineville jurisdiction over portions of certain County  
roads, which are all situated within the corporate limits of the City  
of Prineville, described as:

1. All that portion of Laughlin Road not already  
accepted as a City street which lies East of the  
intersection of North Seventh and Holly Streets to  
the intersection of Laughlin Road with U.S. Highway  
26;
2. Harding Road bordered on the South by U.S. Highway  
26 and on the North by Laughlin Road;
3. Hudspeth Road bordered on the South by Laughlin  
Road and on the North by the Southerly terminus of  
Jordan Lane in the Loma Vista Subdivision as platted  
and filed in the official records of Crook County,  
Oregon;
4. Juniper Street bordered on the South by the center  
of the Juniper Street Bridge over Ochoco Creek and  
on the North by Laughlin Road;

and the aforesaid order further finding that, upon the City of  
Prineville by appropriate ordinance or other municipal legislation  
specifically accepting such offer within ninety (90) days from the date  
of said order, the jurisdiction of the County of Crook over said portions  
of said county roads for their improvement, construction and repair  
should cease, and determine that the full and absolute jurisdiction over  
the same for all purposes of improvement, construction and repair and  
the levying and collecting of assessments therefor shall vest in the City  
of Prineville, and the City of Prineville shall have the same control,  
power and jurisdiction over the same as by its charter and the laws of the  
State given or granted it over any of the public streets now in said City,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE RESOLVE

THAT:

1. The City of Prineville does forthwith accept the offer of Crook County, Oregon, to exercise jurisdiction over portions of certain County roads, all being within the corporate limits of the City of Prineville, to-wit:
  - a. All that portion of Laughlin Road not already accepted as a City street which lies East of the intersection of North Seventh and Holly Streets to the intersection of Laughlin Road with U.S. Highway 26;
  - b. Harding Road bordered on the South by U.S. Highway 26 and on the North by Laughlin Road;
  - c. Hudspeth Road bordered on the South by Laughlin Road and on the North by the Southerly terminus of Jordan Lane in the Loma Vista Subdivision as platted and filed in the official records of Crook County, Oregon;
  - d. Juniper Street bordered on the South by the center of the Juniper Street Bridge over Ochoco Creek and on the North by Laughlin Road.
2. Thereafter, the City of Prineville shall be solely and exclusively responsible for the improvement, construction and repair of said roadways and shall be responsible for the levying and collection of assessments therefor and shall exercise the same control, power and jurisdiction over said roadways as by the City Charter and the laws of the State of Oregon given or granted to the said City to the same extent as it shall have control, power and jurisdiction over any of the public streets and alleys of this City.
