

RESOLUTION NO. 437

THE CITY COUNCIL DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

That the following proposed ordinance of the City of Prineville be presented to the people at a special City election to be held on May 28, 1974:

"ORDINANCE NO. 722


AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING ANY DOG FROM RUNNING AT LARGE AT ANY TIME WITHIN THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE AND PROVIDING PENALTIES.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE, OREGON ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any dog, regardless of age or sex to run at large within the corporate limits of the City of Prineville at any time. Any owner or person in possession or control of a dog found to be running at large shall be punished by imprisonment for a period not to exceed 100 days or by a fine not to exceed \$500.00, or both."
