

RESOLUTION NO. 433

WHEREAS, EPA requires all sewer grant recipients to give assurance that a systematic program for the repair or replacement of leaky sewers will be established,

AND WHEREAS, in order to implement such a program it is necessary to determine the extent of infiltration entering the City sewer system,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of Prineville, Oregon does hereby order the City Sewer System to be tested annually to determine the amount of infiltration into the City Sewer System according to the following schedule:


	<u>Smoke Test-Feet</u>	<u>T.V. Cameras-Feet</u>
February 1974	52,000 feet	-
March 1974	52,000 feet	-
April 1974	52,000 feet	-
October 1974	-	4,000 feet

The Council further resolves that provision be made in the annual fiscal year budgets for the repair or replacement of those lines causing infiltration into the system; said funds to be appropriated from sewer user fees. It shall be further resolved that all repair or replacement of lines causing infiltration shall be corrected in a period of not less than six months from the time of detection.


Resolution No. 422 is hereby rescinded.
