

RESOLUTION NO. 399

WHEREAS, the City of Prineville, Oregon desires to submit a revised application for their Federal Grant request S - Prineville WPC-ORE-222; and

WHEREAS, the need for said sewer system has been fully established by Crook County, Oregon's Comprehensive Study of 1972; and

WHEREAS, the revised sewer system shall be as defined by the City of Prineville's Drawing 672003 and shall serve the presently unavailable areas within the city, and outlying areas which may desire City services; and

WHEREAS, on September 28, 1972 the citizens of the City of Prineville, Oregon, approved a sewer bond measure authorizing the City to issue general obligation bonds for sewer design and construction; and

WHEREAS, the approximate cost of the improvements shall be as follows:


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE City Council of Prineville, Oregon;


THAT the City of Prineville, Oregon hereby applies for a revised grant for the full eligible amount of said grant;
